

Complementary treatments – case study #1

3-year-old dog – treated by Dr Liza Schneider

PROBLEM: Roxy, a bichon frise, had acute disc prolapse and hind limb paresis (a condition typified by partial loss of movement).

TREATMENT: The vet recommended surgery but this was not affordable. Roxy was sent home to rest with some non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs and some pain relief. Three days later Roxy couldn't stand and had made no improvement. Her owners wanted a second opinion.

Liza treated her with acupuncture and herbal medicine as well as chiropractics. Further treatment was completed with the above treatments including an additional five daily sessions of hyperbaric oxygen therapy. Roxy was walking on her own within a week of treatment without the use of conventional medication.

Case study #2

13-year-old cat – treated by Paulette Carpenter

PROBLEM: Stress and sadness.

TREATMENT: Just before September 2010, Shaq's brother died. A month later the Christchurch earthquake struck and the family home was lost. The family moved to a rental home and Shaq's sleeping patterns and normal routine were severely disrupted.

Shaq lost 3kg, which is substantial for a cat. He had become increasingly stiff and sore in the back legs and very clingy. It was clear he was a sad and stressed cat.

Paulette consulted with Shaq's owner via email and phone and selected a remedy. The owner reported that after the first dose Shaq had a very long sleep and, upon waking, was visibly more relaxed.

He was calmer and more settled in his sleep and his appetite returned. Shaq's fur was softer and shinier, his joints were not as sore and he gained 400gm – all within the first five days of taking the remedy.

Case study #3

12-year-old horse – treated by Dr Liza Schneider

PROBLEM: No one knew what was wrong with Jock. He seemed fine, but when his training got to a certain level his health would begin to deteriorate. Jock would unexpectedly injure legs, get a snotty nose or just simply lose his zest for life.

TREATMENT: Initially Liza worked with Jock's owner over the phone and developed a supplement and homeopathic/herbal regime to support Jock's immune system and detoxify his body.

Soon Jock was a lot happier, but his snotty nose persisted and he was still reluctant to work.

With a minor adjustment to his supplement regime and two NIS treatments, Jock is a different horse. His health is excellent and he's working again and loving it. 🐾

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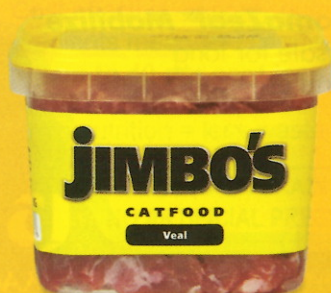


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
